1 in 5 people suffer from mental illness; approximately **57.7 million Americans every year.**





Nearly half of people with a mental illness have a **co-occurring substance abuse disorder.**

Nearly 60%

of American adults with a mental illness **DO NOT** receive treatment.

50% of all lifetime cases of mental illness begin by age 14 and **75% by age 24.**



Depression is the leading cause of disability worldwide, and is a major contributor to the global burden of disease.



16 Million

6.9% (16 Million) of **American adults live with major depression.**

42 Million

18.1% (42 million) of American adults **live** with anxiety disorders.



Suicide

90% of people who die by suicide have an underlying mental illness. Suicide is the10th leading cause of death in the U.S.

\$193.2 Billion

Serious mental illness costs America \$193.2 Billion in lost earning **every year.**
